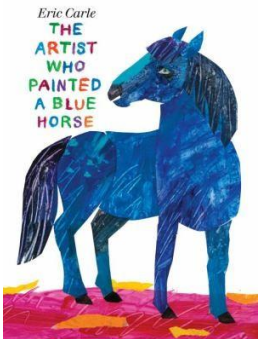

### Reading Readiness Tips:

In books like *Kindness Makes Us Strong*, pointing and running your finger under the words as you are reading helps your child to understand that the text has meaning and tells the story of what is happening in the pictures. This is actually a literacy skill that children need before they learn to read, called Print Awareness – knowing how a book works and how to follow the words on a page. Try using this approach to sharing words as you and your child notice labels and signs as you go through the day. Point out the words as you read them and say, “This says [blank]”. This will grow your child’s vocabulary and their understanding of how print works!
