Notes on the Collection

Historical Note

Born in Pittsburgh in 1904, Donald S. Steinfirst was the classical music critic for the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette from 1939 - 1972. He reviewed concerts by most of the world's top orchestras and musicians, as well as chamber music, opera, and ballet. Steinfirst travelled to Europe for the Post-Gazette to review music festivals and traveled with the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra several times on European tours. During the 1960s he taught music criticism at Duquesne University. He was the executive director of the Three Rivers Arts Festival from 1961 - 1968.
