Notes on the Collection

Historical Note

Frederic Archer was the inaugural organist and music director of the Carnegie Music Hall in Pittsburgh, 1895-1901 where he performed over 400 organ recitals. Archer was the first conductor of the Pittsburgh Orchestra, 1896-1898.
