Notes on the Collection

Historical Note

Wife of George H. Wilson, Manager of Carnegie Music Hall and Manager of the Art Society from 1895 until his death in 1908. Kate DeN. Wilson (1855-1942) then took over as manager of Carnegie Music Hall and the Art Society. She served for 25 years, retiring in 1930. Kate D. Wilson served as secretary and treasurer of the Tuesday Musical Club 1909-1930. She retired in 1930 and returned to her native Massachusetts.
