Notes on the Collection

Historical Note

Walter McClintock (1870-1949) lived with the Native American Blackfoot Indian Tribe for many years and authored many books about their society and customs. Poia, an opera based on the Blackfoot tribe, was composed by Arthur Nevin at the request of McClintock. Arthur Nevin (1871-1943), brother of composer Ethelbert Nevin, was born in Edgeworth, PA. Poia was performed at the Carnegie Music Hall in Pittsburgh, Jan 16, 1907, and in Berlin in 1910.

Scope and Content Note

The collection contains a scrapbook by Walter McClintock from 1905-1914 with clippings relating to McClintock's book "Old North Trail" and the performance of Arthur Nevin's opera "Poia" in Berlin, a full score of "Poia - Oper in Drie Akten" published in 1910 with music by Arthur Nevin and libretto by Randolph Hartley, and 5 large format photographs from the stage production of "Poia" in Berlin, 1910.
